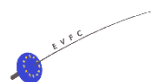

II – Entry fee, Accreditation and Participation Confirmation

- 1 The Entry fee is 260 EUR per team. The Entry fees must be paid directly to the organizer, in cash (EUR), when collecting accreditations.
- 2 Accreditations will be issued during the whole Championships (according to the schedule in the program) until the day before the last day of competition.
- 3 Competitors and other participants may confirm their participation at the competition venue (Intersport Hall) according to the schedule in the program.
- 4 The official hotel is **Hotel Albatros**, ****

5 Accreditation, competitors need:

- A valid passport or identity card (for identification, proof of European Citizenship and confirmation of date of birth) and, if fencing for a country other than of his or her birth, proof of ordinary residence for the required period in that country.
- A valid licence card from the national fencing federation for whom the participant is registering to compete.

- 5 Competitors need to get accredited by 13:00 on the day before their competition at the latest. Accredited competitors do not need to make any additional application with the DT to enter the competition.

- 3 Information regarding the competition (start lists, daily bulletin, results) will be available to the Heads of Delegation in pigeon holes at the competition venue (Intersport Hall). Groups for following days and results of the previous days will be posted on the information boards at the venue and in the official hotel.
- 4 There will be no organized transportation between hotels and the competition venue as they are very close to one another.

IV –Competition Formula and Equipment Control

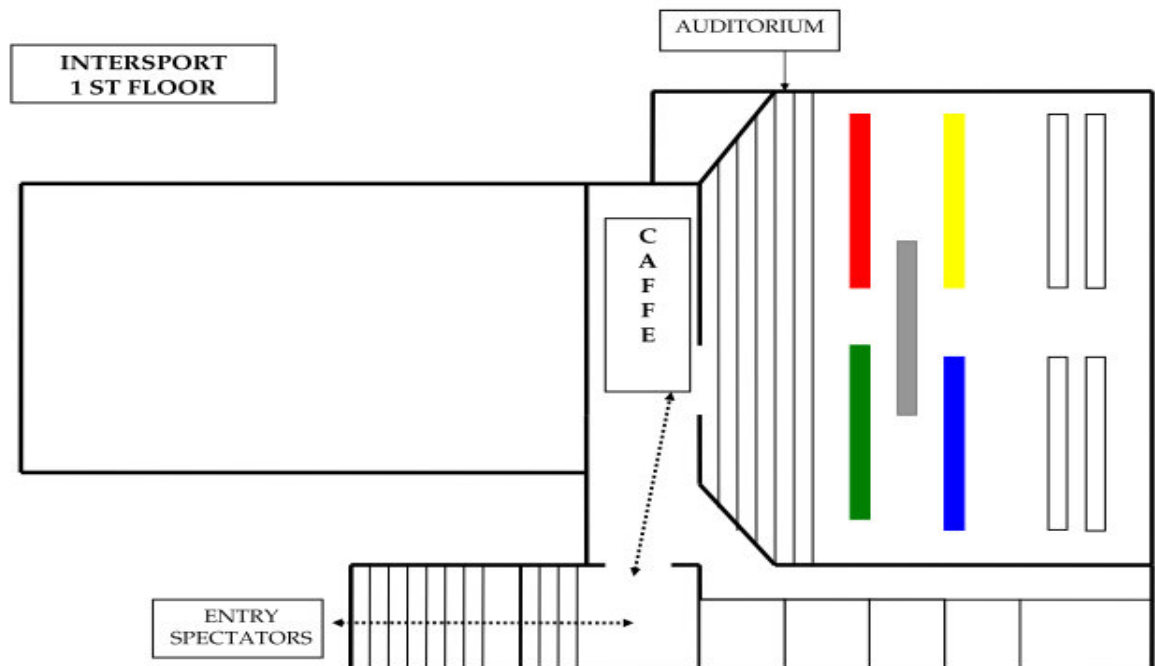
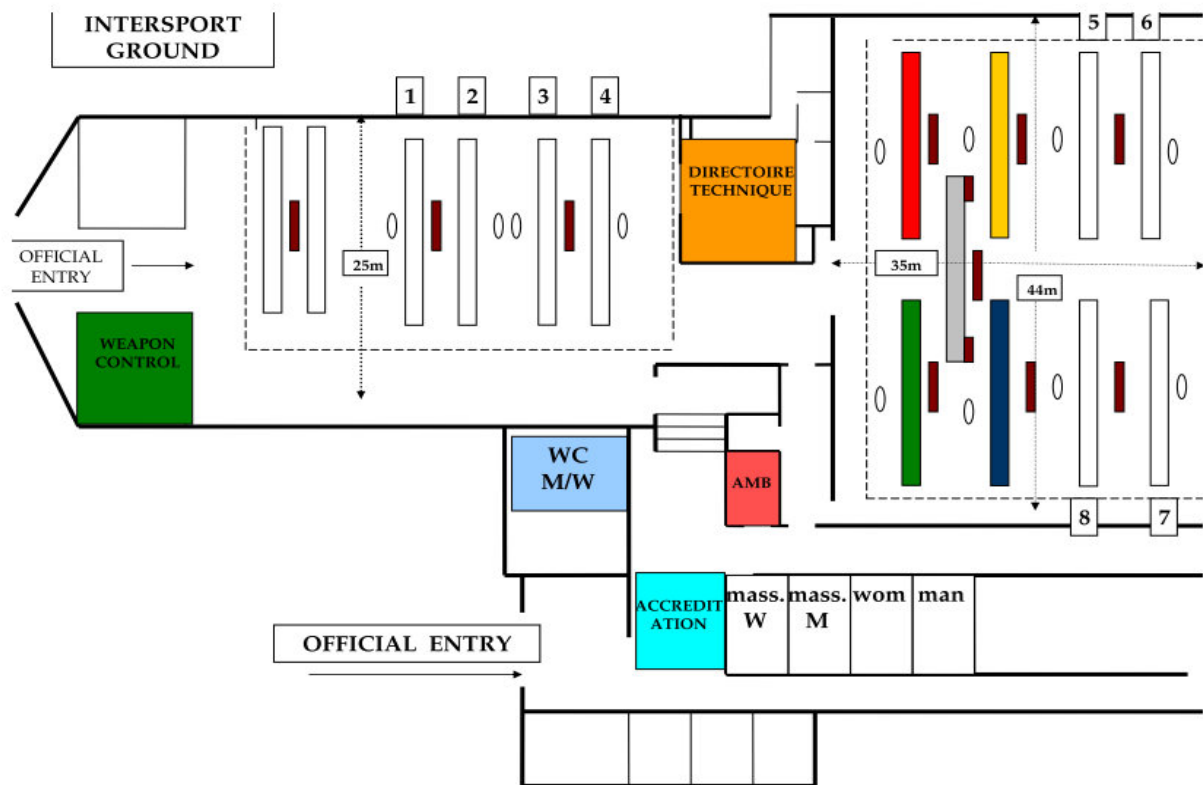
1. Competition will be carried out **according to the EVFC rules for European Veterans Championships (dated 19th November 2013)**
2. The losers of the semi- finals have to fence for the Bronze medal.
3. Results will be processed in **En Garde** program.
4. Equipment control will be conducted according to the schedule in the program, and additional control only before the final bouts.
5. There will be no doping control.

V – Competition Venue, Training

- 1 . The competition will take place on 12 pistes and 1 final at the Intersport Sports Centre (Zelena Laguna, Poreč).
A total of 9 pistes will be set up in Hall A: the finals piste, coloured pistes – red, blue, yellow and green, and 4 additional pistes numbered 5-8
2. A total of 7 pistes will be set up in Hall B: pistes numbered 1-4 and 2 unnumbered training pistes
3. Training will be possible in Hall B on 6 pistes on 15 May , on 2 training pistes and free pistes from time to time in Hall B from 16 May on, after the competition starts.
4. Competition area equipment and control: **PBT** (Hungary)
5. A **PBT representative** fencing equipment sales stand will be set up during the Championships.
6. There will be a cafe with food and drinks at the competition venue
7. There will be a Internet corner in the competition venue (2 computers with internet access)

General Information

Climate

Poreč has a mild Mediterranean climate. Summers are delightfully warm, with low humidity and more than 10 hours of sun daily. Sea temperatures in summer peak at 28°C, which is higher than in South Adriatic. Winds in the region of Poreč are moderate; mostly the light mistral in summer. Winters are temperate and snow is very rare.

Language

The official language is Croatian. Many people speak English and German.

Time Zone

GMT (Greenwich Mean Time) +1. From March through October, during DST, it is GMT +2

Mains Power

The voltage in Croatia is 230 V, 50 Hz, like in the rest of Europe.

Currency Exchange

1 € = 7,6 HRK

The basic Croatian currency unit is KUNA. There are 1 and 2 kuna coins, 5 kuna coins and notes, and 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500, 1000 kuna notes. 1 KUNA has 100 LIPAS, with coins ranging from 1, 2, 5, 10, 20 to 50 lipas. Foreign currencies can be exchanged in banks, exchange offices, post offices, etc.

Bank Work Hours

Banks and exchange offices are open 8 - 19 Monday through Friday and 8 - 12 Saturdays. Most banks have ATMs, which operate 24 hours a day. Banks at the Zagreb Airport are open 7 - 21 daily (including Sundays and holidays).

Post Offices

Post boxes in Croatia are yellow and post collection times are indicated on the post boxes. The main post office in Poreč is in Vukovarska Street. Work hours: 7 - 21 Monday through Friday, 7 - 19 Saturdays.

Work Hours

Work hours of governmental offices are 8:30 - 16:30 Monday through Friday. Most shops and department stores are open non-stop 8 - 20 Monday through Friday, 8 - 15 Saturdays and 8 - 13 Sundays.

Tipping

A service charge is already included in restaurant bills, but it is customary to "round up" the amount of a restaurant bill. Hotel personnel usually expect tips of 10-30 kunas for their services.

Credit Cards

All major credit cards, such as American Express, Diners Club, Eurocard/Master Card, Visa, and JCB, are usually accepted in Croatia and their logos displayed in points of sale.

Alcohol Law

The legal drinking age in Croatia is 18 years.

Telephone

Public phones take only phone cards, which can be purchased in post offices and department stores. To call Poreč from abroad, dial the international code for Croatia 385, the Poreč area code 52 and then the desired telephone number. GSM mobile networks are available. Please check compatibility with your operator.

Medical Services – General Information:

No vaccination or other medical certificates are required to enter Croatia. Health insurance is not mandatory.

Pharmacies are open 7 – 20.

In case of illness or injury dial 94 free of charge to call an ambulance.

Police:

Dial 92 free of charge

Taxi in Poreč:

The reception desk of each hotel can call a taxi for you. The taxi stand in the town of Poreč is next to the Poreč Bus Terminal.

Taxi fares from the Pula Airport to the Zelena Laguna resort and hotels in Poreč are to be negotiated with the taxi driver.
